- The display features 2.1 million twinkling lights. If all the strands of lights were put end-to-end, it would stretch to Mars! (That's Mars, PA).
- The display lights 15 acres of the Westmoreland Fairgrounds with 5 acres accessible to the guests through Christmas Village.
- The display draws enough electricity to light a small community of homes with every single light and electrical appliance turned on at the same time.
- The electricity used could turn on over 100,000 one hundred watt bulbs all at the same time.
- Over 1/4 of a mile of fencing guides guests through the lights. This fence, which is one of the most simple displays at Overly's Country Christmas® is the most difficult to erect. The fence alone has 18,000 miniature white lights.
- Throughout Christmas Village, guests hear the sound of Christmas through an audio system that rivals any sound system used for major live concerts throughout the country. Over 4 miles of audio cable connect all the speakers utilizing over 15,000 watts of power.
- White lights are Overly's Country Christmas® signature. Color lights are used sparingly, for accent only.
- Every display viewed at Overly's Country Christmas® is conceived, designed and constructed on site, usually by volunteers.
- It takes up to 45 volunteers each night to run the display and Christmas Village.
- Overly's Country Christmas® has nearly 600 volunteers committed throughout the year to carry on the tradition Harry Overly created more than half a century ago.
